0915-1015: <u>U.S. Senator Richard G. Lugar</u>, R-IN, Mayor of Indianapolis 1968-75; elected to US Senate Nov 2, 1976; reelected to each succeeding Senate term; Ranking member Senate foreign Relations Committee; member & former chairman, Agriculture, Nutrition & Forestry Committee; co-author of 1991 Nunn-Lugar Cooperative Threat Reduction Program resulting in deactivation of over 7,600 strategic nuclear warheads and destruction of 791 ICBMs previously targeting the US; former USN intelligence briefer for ADM Arleigh Burke, CNO.

1015-1115: <u>Maj. Gen. Omer "Clif" Tooley, Jr.</u>, Assistant Adjutant General of the Indiana National Guard, with duty as Senior Mission Commander of Camp Atterbury-Muscatatuck Center for Complex Operations (CA-MCCO). Regular Army officer for 29 years including 101<sup>st</sup> and 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Divisions, and 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division. Also served in 38<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, INARNG, and Institute for Military Assistance. US Army War College graduate; awarded three Legions of Merit, two Indiana Distinguished Service Medals and Indiana Public Service Award.
